In 1998, Measure K was passed for \$27M for facilities and technology services in the district.

The district currently has five funds related to facilities and construction in the district. Additionally, the district uses the general fund to support maintenance of facilities.

Certificate of Deposits (COPs) have been issued in 2010 and 2017 to complete projects in the district.

STATUS/DISCUSSION:

The board has requested information on the activities related to the Measure K bond, and next steps on a master facility report. Both items will be discussed with the board as well as current facility funding and future state funding with the goal of taking next steps to create a master facility plan.
