

Student Isolation/Quarantine Chart:

**Isolation:** Once a person has tested positive, one must isolate themselves from uninfected people.

**Quarantine:** When a person has been exposed to someone who has tested positive, one must quarantine to restrict his/her movements in case they become infected.

*Day of exposure, day symptoms start, or test date if positive with no symptoms is day zero*

<b>Exposed Outside of School Setting</b>	<p>No Quarantine</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Remain in school</li> <li>Wear a mask for 10 days.</li> <li>Should test 3-5 days after exposure</li> <li>Should symptoms develop, this is considered “presumed positive” and the positive process of 10 day Isolation will begin. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>May return day 6 with a negative test taken on day 5 and no or improved symptoms</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<p>Full Quarantine</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Return day 6 with a negative test taken on day 5 and no symptoms</li> <li>Wear a mask for 10 days</li> <li>Should symptoms develop, this is considered “presumed positive” and the positive process of 10 day Isolation will begin. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>May return day 6 with a negative test taken on day 5 and no or improved symptoms</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>Exposed Outside of School Setting – Household Exposure</b>	<p>No Quarantine</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Remain in school</li> <li>Wear a mask for 10 days.</li> <li>Test 5 days after exposure</li> <li>Positive household member should <i>isolate</i> from the rest of the household</li> <li>Should symptoms develop, this is considered “presumed positive” and the positive process of 10 day Isolation will begin. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>May return day 6 with a negative test taken on day 5 and no or improved symptoms</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<p>Full Quarantine</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Quarantine starts for the student when the positive household member has completed their isolation (after negative test or completion of 10 days) or the day the positive household member was able to effectively isolate in the home</li> <li>Return day 6 with a negative test taken on day 5 and no symptoms</li> <li>Wear a mask for 10 days</li> <li>Should symptoms develop, this is considered “presumed positive” and the positive process of 10 day Isolation will begin. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>May return day 6 with a negative test taken on day 5 and no or improved symptoms</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
