## Student Isolation/Quarantine Chart:

**Isolation**: Once a person has tested positive, one must isolate themselves from uninfected people.

**Quarantine**: When a person has been exposed to someone who has tested positive, one must quarantine to restrict his/her movements in case they become infected.

Day of exposure, day symptoms start, or test date if positive with no symptoms is day zero
