All essays will be read by three judges and scored. Winners at each grade level will be awarded in January. All participants will receive a Certificate of Participation. Winners will receive:

- A Certificate of Participation and a Bronze Medal

Winning essays advance to regional competition. Regional winners advance to State. National winners are invited to receive an award at the 132<sup>nd</sup> DAR Continental Congress Convention in Washington DC, June 2023.
