Because the safety, peace of mind, and health of our families and staff is of utmost importance to us, we wanted to reach out to you again to let you know latest details and information regarding COVID-19.

We are aware that Elk Grove Unified School District has made the decision to take their spring break early and close all their campuses for this upcoming week. We understand there are many concerns around COVID-19 and want to ensure families that we are working closely with El Dorado County Public Health, Marshall Hospital, the El Dorado County fire chiefs, and El Dorado County Office of Education for updates and guidance. In addition, all district superintendents in our county will participate in a daily conference call with the El Dorado County Office of Education (EDCOE), after they have communicated with the agencies mentioned above each day. Each district also has been given a direct phone number to the El Dorado County Public Health Department personnel in charge in case something occurs and we need immediate support and guidance.

Thankfully, at this point in time, we do not have any positive cases of COVID-19 in our county. We will continue to monitor this situation and keep you informed.
