The Rescue Union School District Nutrition Services Department will provide an opportunity for families to pick up meals for the children in their family during our school closures at three locations.

To ensure the nutritional well-being of our students while at home or under other care, our district will be distributing FREE breakfast and lunch bagged meals every day, Monday-Friday during the school closure, starting Monday, March 16, for any child 18 years of age or younger to take home. No paperwork is required. This will be a drive up or walk up service, where we will hand you the meals for each child that is in your vehicle, or care.

This is a pickup service only, and no meals will be consumed on site.

We will provide these free breakfast and lunch bagged meals at the following locations:

- Pleasant Grove Middle School look for the pop-up awning in the bus loop area 2540 Green Valley Road Meals will be available between 11:00-1:00.
- Outside the **Green Valley School** Office building at 2380 Bass Lake Road from 11:00-12:00.
- **Knolls at Green Valley Apartments,** on the corner of Cambridge Road and Cimarron Road we will have a vehicle with lunches available from 12:00-1:00 pm.

Families may walk or drive up to receive their meals at these locations and take the meals home to eat. We encourage families to continue to be proactive in reducing the risk of COVID-19 by not congregating at the school site and utilizing social distancing once meals have been distributed.
