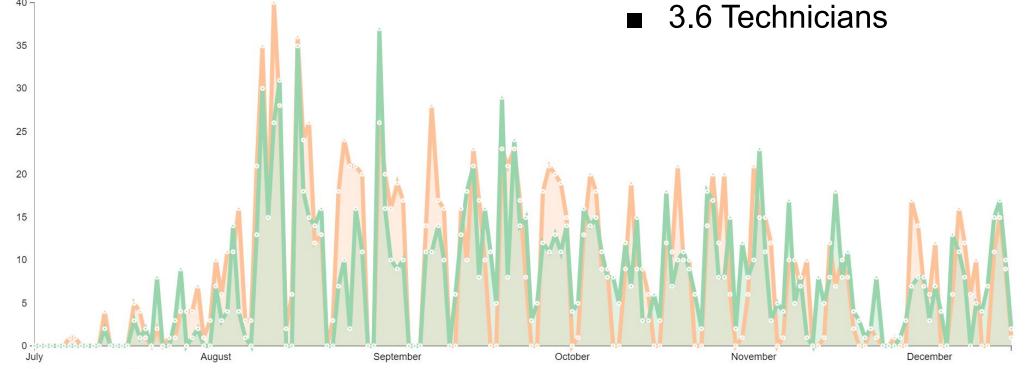
## **Technology Department Stats**

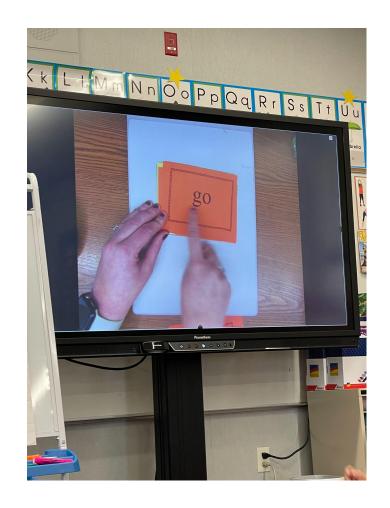




## Department Future Projects and Goals
