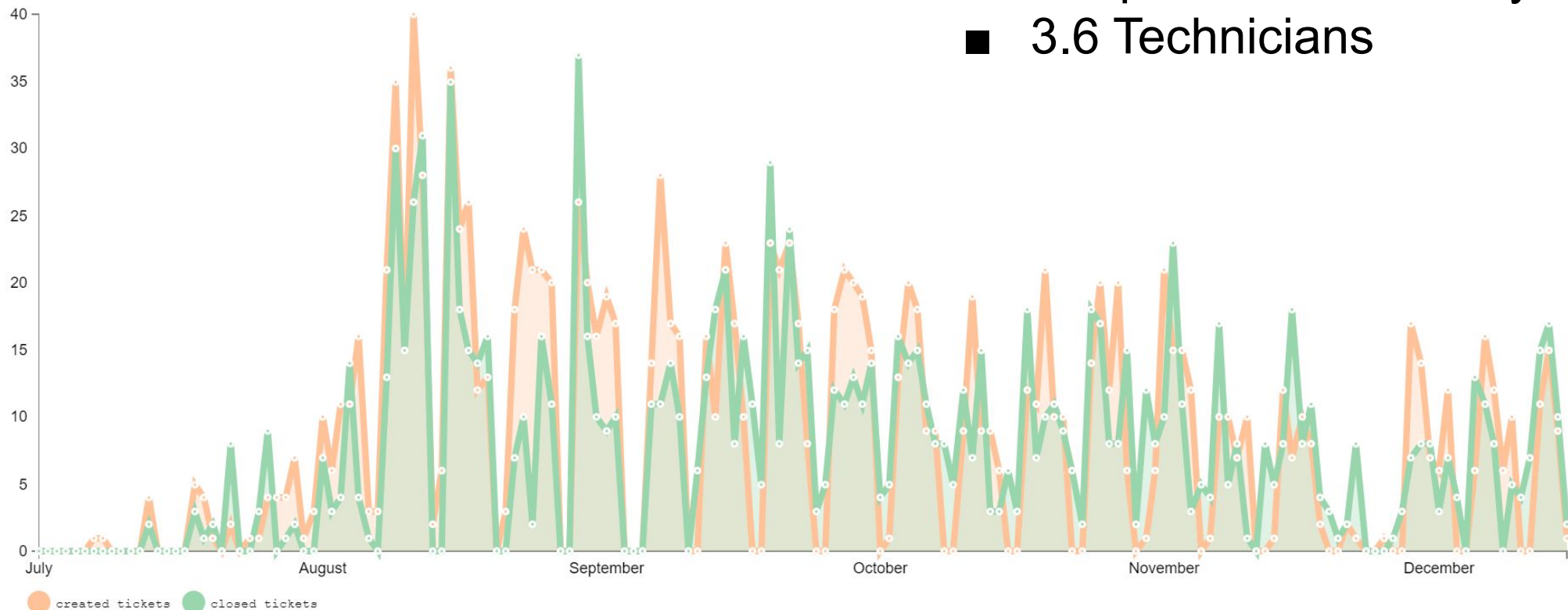
Technology Department Stats

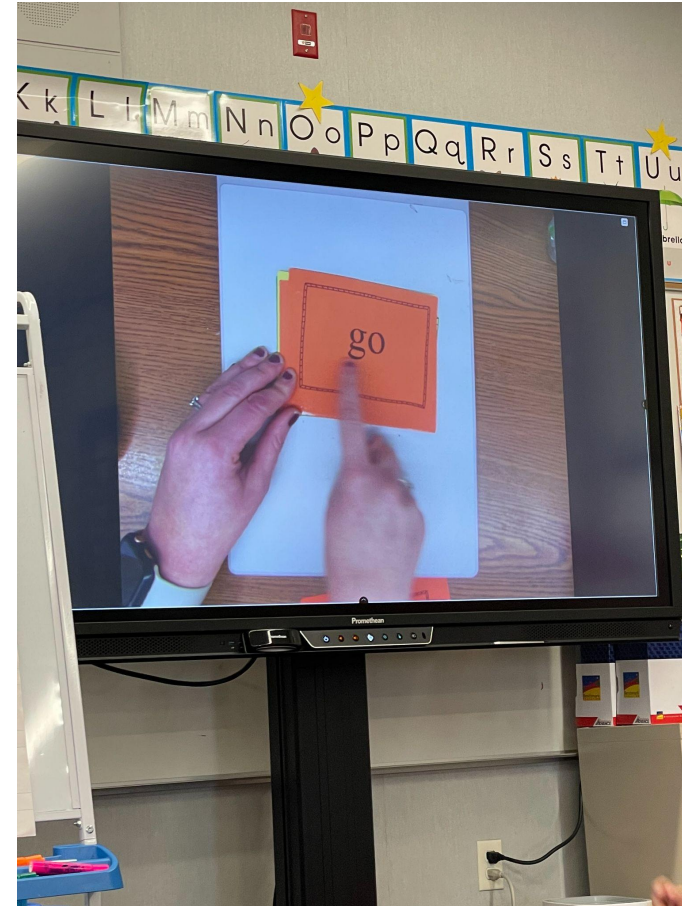
